WOMEN SAFETY AT WORKPLACE

Purpose of the study:-

To register the ratios of the female labour force and the affected working professionals as per WICCI report to ensure means for women safety at work place.

Need for the study:-

To retain female workforce to enhance the socio-economic development of the nation in general and to advocate standup measures to victims to live as empowered and dignified women workforce.

Methodology:-

Reports - News events, real time stories.

Analysis:-

- a) Female labour force is 19.27% out of 48.04% female population in India.
- b) The endangered female workforce seeking safety is more than 50%.

Live examples:-

- Medical officer at Gopichatpalyam harassed a woman co-worker as per the Medical Dialogues Barato report.
- Pechammal, a construction labourer at Thotakudi redefined herself as a male - Mathu, to raise her daughter.

Recommendations to combat VAWW:-

- Develop Zero tolerance approach
- Participate in Wellness programs
- Connect with women wings and seek the guidance of NGOs.
- Use discretion to end cyber bullying
- Avoid unnecessary and unsolicited postings on social sites
- Be assertive and invulnerable
